FROM THE EDITORS:

The winter period was generally mild and dry well into January, which may well account for lingering of some of the heartier species among our typical summer residents. In this regard, Christmas Count and other records showed notable numbers of species such as House Wrens, Mockingbirds, Lesser Goldfinches, and Lark Sparrows. More unusual were hummingbirds, nighthawks, and Sprague Pipit at Las Cruces, Longbilled Curlews, Pectoral Sandpiper, Franklin Gulls, and Wilson Warbler in the lower Pecos Valley area, and Violet-green Swallow at Bosque del Apache N. W. R. Gnatcatchers also lingered in the winter period, but identification to species is still a perplexing problem.

Besides the lingerers, the winter period was also marked by notable incursions of northerly and/or montane species, such as Rough-legged Hawks, Merlins, Western and Mountain bluebirds, and--locally--such cardueline finches as Cassin Finches, Pine Grosbeaks, and American Goldfinches. Add to these some typical easterly birds e.g. Oldsquaws, White-winged Scoter, Yellow-shafted Flickers, and Snow Buntings (!), and one can see that winter was a mixed bag for the state.

In contrast to winter, spring was cooler than normal--with spotty percipitation. Migration was not spectacular, and some summer species were later than normal in returning. Vagrants were few during the period, perhaps the most notable being a likely Louisiana Waterthrush in the Sandia Mountains--with an Arctic Loon nearby--for the first report for the state. Also noteworthy were Little Blue Heron and California Gull in the northwest, Elf Owl and Varied Thrush in the east, and Common Grackles continued their westward expansion (Zuni) and consolidation (Farmington). Continued work in the Pecos Valley by the team Axelrod-Hildebrandt-Howe yield much basic information for the area, including northerly records of such species as Lesser Nighthawk, Crissal Thrasher, Summer Tanager, and Painted Bunting.

Breeding also began in the period, including by herons, Marsh Hawks, and Black-necked Stilts in the lower Pecos Valley area, Long-eared Owl near Portales, and probably by Eastern Bluebirds at Ft. Sumner. Along with the latter, other notable breeding was reported, including Harris Hawk near Alamogordo (a first for the Tularosa Basin) and Costa Hummingbird in Guadalupe Canyon (a first for the state).

Readers will note some changes in this edition of the <u>Field Notes</u>, including a streamlining of reports. For example, we are now using asterisks to indicate substantiation levels for records that such is desirable. The symbols are explained below. We are still using abbreviations to signal the significance of reports, such as winter records (win/rec), unusual records (uns/rec), and so on. We hope that this is helpful. We would also like to request that all of you continue to submit reports with details for unusual records, plus your assessments on status, et cetera. It is helpful if you place your records in taxonomic order. We welcome your comments on our handling of your records.

BLACK-HEADED GROSBEAK: sp/rec - 2+ Boones Draw 5/13 (JH+).

BLUE GROSBEAK: sp/rec - 2+ Boones Draw 5/12 (JH+).

<u>INDIGO BUNTING</u>: sp/rec - 9 at L. McMillan 5/11-12 (WH+), plus singles near Anthony 4/30 and 5/4 (KZ) and at Capitan 5/31 (CM).

LAZULI BUNTING: sp/rec - 10 at L. McMillan 5/4-21 (WH+).

VARIED BUNTING: sp/rec - 2 at Rattlesnake Springs 5/30 (JD).

PAINTED BUNTING: uns/rec - 2 n.e. of Roswell 5/17 (WH+) were north of the usual range.

<u>RED CROSSBILL</u>: br/rec - adult feeding a fledgling at Cedar Spring, Carson National Forest, Rio Arriba Co., (AN). win/rec - 39 in the Zuni Mts. near Thoreau 12/15 (AN+).

<u>GREEN-TAILED TOWHEE</u>: uns/rec - 1 at Glenwood 12/29 (JH+) was a local first for winter.

<u>RUFOUS-SIDED</u> <u>TOWHEE</u>: win/rec - 2 near Thoreau 12/15 (AM+); sp/rec - 1 near Montoya 3/6 (JH).

BLACK-CHINNED SPARROW: win/rec - 1 near Glenwood (JH+) and 5 near Cliff (RF+) 12/29.

LARK SPARROW: win/rec - 1-3 at Bosque N. W. R. 12/22 (DL+), Silver City 12/15 (RF+), Rodeo 12/29 (RS+), Las Cruces 12/15 (TM+), Alamogordo 12/15 (LM+), and White Oaks 1/9 (VG). uns/rec - 2 reported without details at Las Vegas 12/16 (JG+).
