FROM THE PRESIDENT

Steve West

I was elected President of the New Mexico Ornithological Society at the 1987 meeting held in Carlsbad last May. I first joined the NMOS at an Albuquerque meeting on 16 May 1964, and have been a member since that time. During those 23 years, I have seen a lot happen with the Society; others who have lived closer to the Society's center of activity have seen much more. A statewide ornithological society in one of the largest (314,923 sq km; 5th in size) but least densely populated (37th in population density) states in the nation would almost inevitably have a rough time surviving.

All of us have seen the Society go through various stages of activity and inactivity, although generally something has been happening. The Society is run by a group of volunteers who receive no remuneration for their work, any of whom would probably rather be out chasing birds than chasing down people to submit records for the <u>Field Notes</u>, send in dues, or submit articles for the <u>Bulletin</u>.

Lately, several officers of the Society have had to field questions from long-time members wondering what is happening to the NMOS: no <u>Field Notes</u>, no <u>Bulletin</u>, no notice of annual meetings. I as well as anyone know all of this to be true. For example, I never even received a notice for the spring meeting which was to be held here in Carlsbad. Other members began contacting me with questions that had come about after they had received and looked over their notices. A phone call to our able Treasurer, Ross Teuber, got a copy of the meeting announcement for me (and added my correct address to the mailing list).

The truth is that, yes, the Society has been very inactive of late. I want to change that but it won't be easy trying to do so all the way from Carlsbad. Toward that end, however, a few positive things have happened that I feel will help to get us back on track. A set of Field Notes has been published after a very long absence of such. Another set is making the rounds to the various editors and will, hopefully, be out before long. This issue of the Bulletin is the first to come out in a much longer time; Dr. Sartor O. Williams III has agreed to serve as Bulletin Editor. Les Hawkins has agreed to be in charge of the spring meeting to be held next March in Albuquerque. Paul Steel and Ross Teuber have spent many hours bringing the membership list up to date. There is a lot to be done and a lot that hasn't been done, but there are good indications that this is beginning to change. If you would like to help make the Society work, volunteer to work. We'll find something for you to do.

FROM THE EDITOR

When I became a member of the NMOS, back in 1982, the <u>Bulletin</u> and the <u>Field Notes</u> seemed to arrive on a fairly regular basis. Over the past couple of years, however, the <u>Bulletin</u> essentially ceased publication. When I began inquiring into what had happened to the <u>Bulletin</u> and asking if there was anything I could do to help I was offered the job of Editor. (There may be a lesson there, somewhere...) Anyway, in late August I accepted the job, and so with this issue I assume the editorship of the NMOS <u>Bulletin</u>.

My first priority is to get the <u>Bulletin</u> back on schedule, i.e., four issues per year, published on time. You're holding 1986 (Vol. 14, Nos. 1-4) in your hands. If all goes well, 1987 (Vol. 15) will be published, possibly in two issues, before the end of this year. We can then enter 1988 essentially "caught up," and can look forward to four full issues for Vol. 16.

I will provide more detailed instructions for <u>Bulletin</u> contributors in a future issue. In the meantime, however, we should all keep in mind that the NMOS is an ornithological society, and that the Society's Bulletin is the proper place for papers dealing with New Mexico ornithology. Of particular

interest are articles describing changes in the distribution and/or status of New Mexican birds, details of significant state records (including nesting records), summaries of banding studies and nesting studies, and analyses of Christmas Bird Counts and other censuses. Other topics of interest include field identification articles (how many of you out there really can, with confidence, separate the two ravens?), notes on interesting behavior, and locality articles describing areas that are ornithologically unique in New Mexico. Notes relating to conservation, particularly of endangered, rare, or otherwise unusual New Mexican birds (and their habitats) are also welcome.

The "News and Announcements" section is intended to be a regular feature. I hope that this section will be used as an open bulletin board for the interchange of information relating to New Mexican birds, such as notices of meetings, notices of studies planned or in progress, and requests for assistance or information.

But the main point I want to get across right now, however, is that the NMOS in general, and the <u>Bulletin</u> in particular, are alive and well. Let us hear from you!
